A Four Year Plan for Applied Trumpet

The following is a four year plan for applied study in trumpet. The methods and expectations listed here are intended as a guide not as an absolute. Students may be ahead or behind the stated requirements. The point of this plan is to show a gradual progression which will prepare the student for a professional in music education, performance, or graduate study. The methods and etudes listed are not to be discounted after the year in which they are mentioned is over. Methods such as Arban and Clarke are for lifelong use and will constantly be referred to. Through out a four year plan students should become familiar with the standard repertoire both from personal performances and recordings. Students are also expected to read recommended texts that will aid the mental side of trumpet performance as well as other books dealing with the history of the trumpet, important performers and other relevant items that relate to the trumpet.

Freshman Year:

Students should acquire the standard methods that will be used throughout their playing careers. Also Students will be expected to have a solid understanding of tone production. Late in the year students, if they do not play one yet, should play the C trumpet as well as the Bb trumpet. Simple transposition exercises will be introduced from selected studies that are listed below.
